Libya Martyrs Return Home from Palestine

On Wednesday evening the remains of three Libyan martyrs who died fighting for the liberation of Palestine arrived in Tripoli International Airport.

An official red carpet and heroes reception was held for martyrs attended

by senior officials and the families and relatives of the martyrs.

The martyrs, Ali Ibrahim Nwaidhah, Khalid Mohammed Al-Ma'alul and Said A'araibi Khalifa, all participated in military operations against Israeli

occupation of Palestine and sacrificed their lives defending a noble cause.

The senior officials and relatives and many others received the three coffins which were covered by the green Libyan flag with roses and prayers and chants

that expressed the pride of everyone as a result of these heroes' sacrifice.

Transparency Verification Committee Issues Its Report

Tripoli- The Transparency Verification Committee (TVC) released on Tuesday its long awaited report on the transparency affidavits presented by Libyan public officials and senior personalities in the private sector. The affidavits included information related to income and property.

The TVC said in its report

that only 157 cases have been found to be with improper practices out of 4287 cases. According to TVC, those who presented their affidavits were 4287 people divided into four groups:

Those selected by the General People's Congress, 96 people; holders of leadership positions including military

officers, security apparatuses and similar organizations, 249; Secretaries of GPCs and CEOs of various institutes and companies, 2719 people; and those who were made available to the TVC by the state, 1223 people.

The affidavits with irregularities include 10 people
