## GPC Sets Date for BPCs Meetings

The General People's Congress (GPC) issued a decree on Wednesday setting the date for meetings of Basic People's Congresses (BPCs). The meetings will continue from 12 to 16 October.

The BPCs are required to draw up the agenda of current meeting and ratify the Friendship Partnership and Cooperation Treaty between great Jamahiriya and Italy signed on 30 September 2008.

It is expected that after these meetings the General People's Congress could be called for a session during which important issues related to public policies will be debated.
