Al-Qathafi: Israelis will Never Live in Peace by Slaughtering Palestinian Children

Speaking to Georgetown University's students and faculty, the Leader of the Revolution Muammar Al-Qathafi made it clear on Wednesday that the Israelis won't live in peace by massacring Palestinian children

even if they relied on US protection and the US Sixth Fleet.

Lecturing via a satellite closed circle from Tripoli, Al-Qathafi said "the whole region of the Middle East is a sea of Arabs that it makes it impossible

for the state of Israel to survive even if it kept on using fighter jets, phosphorus bombs, depleted uranium and other banned weapons against the Palestinians."

Israel, he said, wants to have a pure Zionist state with its own

Jewish religion, language and tradition, "but this goal is unattainable in the Middle East where Palestine is considered to be an Arab state similar to

Egypt, Syria Libya, Lebanon

and Tunisia." "It is impossible to even dream of such objective," he added.

Al-Qathafi explained to students and faculty at Georgetown University in
