## Pan African Parliament Declares Solidarity with Al-Megrahi

Tripoli- The Pan African Parliament declared on Wednesday its solidarity with Abdulbaset Al-Megrahi and wished him quick recovery after his release from captivity in Scottish and Netherlands prisons for more than eleven years.

The 150 strong Pan African parliamentarian delegation expressed its support with Al-Megrahi when they made a visit to him at Tripoli Medical Center.

Speaking to Megrahi and the large audience in his presence,

The President of the Pan-African Parliament (PAP) Hon. Dr. Moussa Idriss Ndele, MP said "we wished that this meeting had took place at the Parliament's headquarters [in in Midrand, South Africa] and gave you a red carpet welcome."

Mr. Ndele added that that would have been in response to the big welcome given to the Bulgarian nurses by the European Parliament despite their crime and with disregard to the feelings of over 400 Libyan children who were infected with

AIDS and their relatives.

Al-Megrahi waived his hand to the African parliamentarian delegation as he responded to their words of support and get well wishes.

Al-Megrahi was the only person who unfairly tried and convicted of the 1988 bombing of Pan Am Flight 103 over Lockerbie, Scotland. The Libyan people and the great majority of Africans consider him an innocent man who has paid dearly for a crime he never

## Israel Imposes Blockade on Books for Gaza Schools, Starving Babies

The main United Nations agency caring for Palestinian refugees today called on Israel to lift its blockade of Gaza to allow in educational materials for schools, stressing that these can serve as a major weapon in promoting tolerance and peace.

The Israeli blockade is in

violation of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, UNRWA said.

"It is in the interests of everyone who believes in peace that the blockade of Gaza should be lifted especially for educational materials," spokesman Christopher

Gunness said, referring to the UN Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East.

Mr. Gunness also noted that the agency has still been unable to get building materials into Gaza, which means that 60,000
